Springhurst Park and 160 Lees

- Springhurst Park where the play structures are, basketball court and open spaces are designated 'no dogs allowed'. This designation will remain.
- Currently there is no designation for 160 Lees, which is the huge open field adjacent to Springhurst Park and the apartment buildings.
 160 Lees is property that has been reserved by the City so that the Alta Vista Transportation Corridor could be built, a proposition that the community has fought for decades and hopes to have removed from the City's plans within the next few years.
- What we propose:
- Pathway to the south of the basketball court, pathway linking to the Greystone property, pathway linking Springhurst Ave and the SW corner of the park all to be re-designated 'on-leash permitted' – currently there are no dogs allowed but people use it anyway to get through.
- Pathway and strip of land along the Rideau River to be designated 'dogs onleash permitted'. Currently this is not designated.
- 160 Lees (open fields between Springhurst Park and Lees Ave apartments)
 Dogs off leash seasonally and by time-of-day.
 - Off leash permitted at all times: Oct 1st to May 14th (fields are not booked by sports teams).
 - Off leash permitted by time of day: May 15th September 30th, 9 pm to 9 am; "on-leash permitted" all other times
