### **O**n-Going

Here's a block-by-block breakdown of the work currently underway:

- Hawthorne Avenue and Main Street Intersection:
  Watermain testing and chlorination and electrical work;
- Hawthorne Avenue to Lees Avenue: Relocation of telecommunication cables;
- Lees Avenue to Clegg Street: Silva Cells installation, removal of temporary sidewalk, grading of granular base for cycle track, relocation of telecommunication cables, installation of new traffic signal poles and removal of old Hydro poles; and,
- Clegg Street to the Rideau River: Removal of asphalt and concrete road base, sanitary sewer installation and watermain replacement.

### **Upcoming**

Here are key <u>new</u> upcoming construction activities planned for the next two weeks:

- Harvey Street to Lees Avenue: Road box excavation, concrete curb and removal of temporary sidewalk;
- Lees Avenue to Clegg Street: Concrete sidewalk at intersections, paving of cycle track and installation of brick pavers for sidewalk;
- Brantwood Place Gates: Removal of stone facing;
- Clegg Street to the Rideau River Drive: Watermain installation, and;
- Rideau River Drive: Replacement of lateral connections.

#### Traffic

#### **Main Street**

The northbound lane from Riverdale Avenue to Clegg Street will be closed from May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 9 a.m. to November 2016.

#### **Colonel By Drive / Pretoria Bridge**

The CN Cycle for CHEO event will take place on Sunday May 1<sup>st</sup>. For this event, **Colonel By Drive will be closed to traffic from Hog's Back Road to Rideau Street from 6 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** 

The Pretoria Lift Bridge will be undergoing maintenance work on May 1<sup>st</sup>. In order to complete the work, the **Pretoria Lift Bridge will be closed to traffic on May 1<sup>st</sup> from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m.** The bridge will remain open to cyclists and pedestrians.

The Heroes are Human Capital-to-Capital Ride will take place on Saturday May 7<sup>th</sup>. For this event, there will be a possible rolling closure of the Pretoria Lift Bridge and Colonel By Drive (Hawthorne Road to Rideau Street) from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m.

The Sporting Life 10K Run for CHEO event will take place on Sunday May 8<sup>th</sup>. For this event, Colonel By Drive will be closed to traffic from Hog's Back Road to Clegg Street from 5 a.m. to noon.

The Floral Fireworks for the opening night of the Canadian Tulip Festival will take place on Thursday May 12<sup>th</sup>. For this event, **Colonel By Drive will closed to traffic from Echo Drive (Bank Street access) to Clegg Street from 9 p.m. to 10 p.m.** 

Sunday Bikedays will take place every Sunday from May 15<sup>th</sup> to September 4<sup>th</sup> (except on May 29<sup>th</sup>). For these events, **Colonel By Drive will be closed to traffic from Hog's Back Road to the Laurier Bridge from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.**

### Did you know?

Temporary water services are provided to all buildings while the watermain is shut down for its replacement. This is done using above ground hoses that are connected on side streets on the live watermain side of the "cut and cap". These above ground hoses are placed along the road and front yards and are buried at driveways and intersections. Smaller hoses are used to connect each building at their outside water tap. The hoses are chlorinated and tested prior to being connected to the buildings. The water quality in the temporary system is closely monitored by the City to ensure it meets current Drinking Water Standards.
