## Notice of Completion Main Street Renewal Environmental Study Report

The City of Ottawa has completed an Environmental Assessment of the Main Street Renewal Project. The City has identified the need to reconstruct Main Street (between Echo Drive and the McIlraith Bridge) as an integrated road, sewer and water renewal project, as the existing street infrastructure has reached the end of its life-cycle. The project includes the replacement of underground infrastructure, roadway and surface elements including provision for wider sidewalks, a segregated bike facility, and streetscaping. The Recommended Plan varies along the corridor and includes a combination of two, three and four vehicle lanes.

The City has planned this project under **Schedule C** of the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**. The Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been completed and by this Notice is being placed in the public record for review. Subject to the comments received as a result of this Notice and receipt of necessary approvals, the City intends to proceed to detailed design. Pre-construction activities may commence in 2014 with full construction

planned to commence in 2015.
